OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (A417 WANTAGE - READING ROAD AND ARDINGTON, LOCKINGE, EAST HENDRED AND WEST HENDRED PARISHES) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20**

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order – for road safety reasons – is to replace a section of the 40mph speed limit on the A417 Reading Road in West Hendred, with a **30mph speed limit** either side of its junction with The Greenway as follows:

• from a point 130 metres west of the junction of The Greenway, eastwards for a distance of 369 metres

The Oxfordshire County Council (A417 Wantage – Reading Road and Ardington, Lockinge, East Hendred and West Hendred Parishes) (Speed Limits) Order 2022 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.

Holy Trinity West Hendred Oxford Historic Churches Ride and Stride – 9th September

In June 2023 OHCT very generously awarded a feasibility grant of £1,100 which is for the entire net cost of a Structural Engineer's inspection and report of the Bell Frame and its supports.
