53/24	MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed and approved. Proposed Cllr Clayton, Seconded Cllr Axel-Berg. RESOLVED. The minutes were signed.

55/24	MATTERS ARISING FROM THE PREVIOUS MINUTES a) Noticeboard Maintance – Cllr Axel-Berg had dealt with the external woodwork. Waiting for the leg to be repaired.	Clerk
56/24	UPDATE ON PROPOSED CROSSING ON A417 AND VARIOUS SPEED REDUCTION MEASURES OCC was waiting for an arboricultural assessment on the overhanging tree. Clerk to ask Cllr Povolotsky to chase for an update. The public consultation for the 20mph scheme was due in late May or June. There were only two places in the village where speedwatch could be carried out.	
57/24	SID POLES AND SID UNIT It was noted that Speedwatch could not be carried out where there is an active SID/VAS. The site of the poles would be given by OCC and would be based on strict safety criteria. Speedwatch has been shown to be more effective than SIDs. The total cost of implementation would be around £5k which is 50% of the annual precept. The Parish Council had commissioned two speed monitors from OCC. It was agreed to wait for the data from that.	
58/24	DISTRICT COUNCILLORS REPORT A written report had been circulated. At the meeting Cllr James reported: a) She had been appointed leader of the Green party at the Vale. b) She encouraged the Parish Council to respond to the corporate plan consultation. She pointed out that anything in the plan had to be delivered. c) The Climate Action fund was open for applications until the end of June. d) Grants were also available from the Rural Prosperity Fund and	

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	Magnox. Cllr James was thanked for attending.

60/24	PLAYING FIELD <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Playground Inspection. (Cllr Lloyd for April, Cllr Evans for May). It was again noted that some of the equipment was looking tired. Some of the broken items needed to be removed. Cllr Axel-Berg offered to do this. A stake was required for the birch tree. Clerk to ask Mr Tarrant to do this. The fence was to be looked at in September. b) Agility Trail. Cllr Evans had met with Wicksteed and was awaiting a quote for the agility trail and the swings. He was to contact Proludic for a third quote. It was suggested that the focus be on the swings. Ask Mr Tarrant to remove the old trail. c) Replacement of football nets.
