Gard Reservoir News Update

A Freedom of Information Request by GARD (Group Against Reservoir Development) has obtained the Environment Agency's advice to DEFRA on Thames Water's draft Water Resource Management Plan which recommended that Thames Water is not allowed to publish this plan. "We recommend that: Thames Water is not allowed to publish its plan. The company should make further changes as set out in Section 3. These changes will require regulators to review them before the company's plan is allowed to be published. We also advise that due to the public interest shown in the consultation that Defra considers whether further public scrutiny is required before the plan is published." DEFRA have not made a decision either way yet, and this may be why. Thames Water's new round of consultation and plans may have been planned all along, but it may also be prompted by this advice from the EA.

Public consultation on proposals for South-East Strategic Reservoir Option (SESRO)

A new reservoir located to the south-west of Abingdon in Oxfordshire. This follows the publication last year of our revised draft Water Resources Management Plan 2024, setting out the measures that we propose taking to protect future water supplies and decrease the likelihood of water shortages during prolonged periods of drought.

Oxfordshire County Council Consultation – West Hendred proposed 20mph Speed Limits

Oxfordshire County Council wants to make our built environments safer and more attractive places to walk and cycle. To enable this, 20mph speed restrictions are being used to help promote alternative modes of transport for local travel.

We're therefore asking for your views on the proposal to introduce a 20mph speed within West Hendred, replacing the existing 30mph speed limit on the road south of the A417 Reading Road in its entirety. The proposals are being put forward following concerns raised by the parish over road safety, and form part of a countywide programme of works that seeks to deliver 'a safer place with a safer pace' for the residents of Oxfordshire. Oxford Historic Churches Ride and Stride -14^{th} September.
